The 2013 Annabella Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon is a deep purple color with shimmering red undertones. This classic Napa Cabernet showcases the best of what this region can offer - black plum, cassis, and blackberry leap out of the glass. The wine is impeccably balanced and well-structured, with milk chocolate and espresso flavors mingling with the sweet char of smoky oak, layering together with the smooth and supple tannins that make this massive wine drinkable in its youth. The subtle vanilla finish lingers long after the last sip is gone.
