Tasting Notes:

The 2016 Annabella Cabernet Sauvignon is a stunning example a classic Napa Valley Cabernet. Enticing aromas of cassis, Bing cherry, and a hint of strawberry mingled with tobacco and dark chocolate. In the mouth, the voluptuous, broad wine shows flavors of ripe black cherries, root beer, and graphite, with a textured mid palate perfumed by well-integrated French oak. The finish is exotic with hints of wild flowers and nutmeg.

Enjoy this well-crafted wine with seared filet mignon served with buttered spinach and thyme-roasted sweet potatoes.
