

Annabella 2016 Cabernet Sauvignon

Technical Analysis:

Varietal Cabernet Sauvignon (96%)

Petit Verdot (2%)

Tannat (2%)

Appellation Sonoma County

Alcohol 14.5%

Aging 20 months in French oak

Tasting Notes:

The 2016 Annabella Sonoma County Cabernet Sauvignon has a dark and brooding nose, generous with dark chocolate, spicy mission fig, and a hint of black cherries. In the mouth, the wine shows smoky espresso, blackberries, and ripe cherries, intermingling with clove and white pepper from the sweet char of French oak. The fruity finish gives way to a lingering, delicate brown sugar note.

Enjoy this serious Cabernet with BBQ chicken served with grilled summer squash.
