

Dante 2012~Cabernet Sauvignon

Technical Analysis:

Varietal 87% Cabernet Sauvignon, 10% Zinfandel, 3% Merlot

Appellation California Alcohol 13.5%

Aging 20 months in new and once-used French oak barrels

Tasting Notes:

The 2012 Dante California Cabernet Sauvignon opens with juicy aromas of blackberry, roasted coffee, black cherries, and spicy plum. The broad mouth is dense with flavors of milk chocolate, mocha, and sweet vanilla. The extra-long finish on this easy-drinking Cabernet begs you to go back for another sip.

The Dante Cabernet is like a little black dress - it goes with anything, and dresses up or down in a flash. Pair this ace-in-the-hole with a Kobe beef hamburger with melted brie on a brioche bun, topped with caramelized onions and bacon.
