

Dante 2013~Cabernet Sauvignon

Technical Analysis:

Varietal 90% Cabernet Sauvignon, 10% Merlot

Appellation California Alcohol 14.5%

Aging 18 months in new and once-used French oak barrels

Tasting Notes:

The 2013 Dante Cabernet Sauvignon is a deep red in the glass, with youthful purple undertones. The nose shows bright aromas of raspberry, blueberry, and strawberry jam, while in the mouth the flavors of Bing cherry and milk chocolate mingle well with the balance of lightly-structured tannins and food-friendly acid. The wine is light but dense, easy drinking and well-suited to pairing with your favorite foods.

Try this stellar Cab with a juicy hamburger, topped with bacon and blue cheese, served on a brioche bun with a side of apple coleslaw.
