Tasting Notes:

The 2014 Dante Pinot Noir is a bright and youthful purple red in the glass. The wine opens with expressive aromas of orange peel and violets, raspberries, and a sweet, subtle note of fennel seed. In the mouth, the wine is delicate and lovely, but with a broad, smokey, velvety texture. Flavors of white fig, raspberries, and nutmeg mingle in the mouth, while the sweet smoke of charred oak persists through the lengthy finish.

Enjoy this wine with grilled pork chops served with a wild rice salad and asparagus.
