Tasting Notes:

The 2016 Dante Pinot Noir has a brightly perfumed nose with aromas of fresh strawberries, red plum, and candied cherry, with a light cinnamon spiciness. In the mouth, the wine is soft and pliable, with flavors of rich milk chocolate, strawberry cobbler, and fresh vanilla bean. The finish is delicate and reminiscent of toasted marshmallows.

Enjoy this easy drinking Pinot Noir with rice noodles sautéed with shiitakes, red peppers, and a creamy tahini sauce.
