Tasting Notes:

Our 2013 Pozzan Oakville Zinfandel exudes pedigree and charisma. In the glass, it shimmers with a deep red with youthful purple undertones. The extroverted nose is rich with ripe red raspberries, juicy white peaches, cream soda, and black pepper. In the mouth, the wine is weighty and expressive, with more raspberries, crème caramel, and vanilla bean intertwining with the well-structured matrix of soft, mature tannins. The beguiling, lengthy finish showcases the evocative sweetness of charred, smoky oak.

This versatile Zinfandel would shine with traditional tacos al pastor, as well as with a pan roasted pork tenderloin stuffed with dried figs and goat cheese.

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
