

Matthew Joseph 2016 Cabernet Sauvignon

Technical Analysis:

Varietal Cabernet Sauvignon (98%)

Petit Verdot (2%)

Appellation Napa Valley

Alcohol 13.5%

Aging 12 months in French oak

Tasting Notes:

The 2016 Matthew Joseph Cabernet is dark and brooding. The nose opens slowly, revealing individually compelling aromas of jasmine, rose petals, and ripe black cherries. The mouth is serious and rich, with a broadly-textured mid palate and volatile flavors of red plum, red cherry, and milk chocolate. The soft, lengthy finish is floral and delicate.

Enjoy this striking wine with a pan seared bone-in pork chop, served with caramelized onion-topped polenta and garlicky broccoli.
