

Michael Pozzan 2012~Cabernet Sauvignon

Technical Analysis:

Varietal Cabernet Sauvignon (100%)
Appellation Alexander Valley (90%)
Napa Valley (10%)

Alcohol 14.5%

Aging 14 months in French and American Oak

Tasting Notes:

This alluring Cabernet opens with aromas of root beer, dark plum, and sweet saddle leather. The dense, lush flavors sing with juicy black cherry, blackberry, and creamy mocha. As a Cabernet from the Alexander Valley, this mouth-filling, extracted wine has big bones, but the tannins are buttery soft and linger on the lengthy vanilla cream soda finish.

Enjoy this cabernet with a flank steak marinated in coffee and black peppercorns, served with butter-roasted corn on the cob.
