

## Michael Pozzan 2012~Pinot Noir

## **Technical Analysis:**

Varietal Pinot Noir (100%) Appellation Russian River Valley

Alcohol 13.5%

Aging 16 months in French Oak

## **Tasting Notes:**

This gorgeous, classic Russian River Pinot shows aromas of cherry and pipe smoke, crushed rose petal, and candied orange peel. Juicy flavors of cherry and clove float on the velvety soft tannins, backed by a food-friendly acidity and a perfectly balanced density. The lingering smoky finish makes this an ideal wine for sipping alone, or enjoying with food.

Pairs well with seared duck breast with orange and lavender, sautéed green beans, and polenta with a wild mushroom ragout.
