

Michael Pozzan 2012~Sauvignon Blanc

Technical Analysis:

Varietal	Sauvignon Blanc (100%)
Appellation	Oakville, Napa Valley
Alcohol	13.5%
Aging	100% Stainless Steel

Tasting Notes:

This Sauvignon Blanc is a crystal clear, white stone colored wine possessing intense gooseberry, wintergreen notes and clove scents. The entry of this wine bursts with fresh pink grapefruit and again gooseberry with bone dry acidity but gobs of fruit notes which also include ripe melon and sweet lemon flavors. This wine is an excellent aperitif, but accompanies cheese plates with fresh figs, olives and guava paste. Try it for lunch with thinly sliced smoked turkey, Saint Andre double cream cheese and thin slices of Fuji apples; fantastic!

Some of the finest Sauvignon Blancs from California are from the Napa Valley. It's pure expression of fruit is a fine example of why.

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
