## **Tasting Notes:**

The 2014 Michael Pozzan Napa Valley Sauvignon Blanc opens with an enticing minerality, showing aromas of wet stone and a subtle perfume of jasmine and lychee. The round mouth is textured and dense, with citrus notes dancing through a layered viscosity that persists with a light creamy finish.

This is the consummate oyster wine - enjoy with your favorite dozen on the half shell with a squeeze of lemon and mignonette, or a spinach salad with grilled prawns, dried cranberries, and mandarin vinaigrette.
