Technical Analysis:

Varietal	Sauvignon Blanc (92%) Pinot Blanc (5%) Semillon (3%)
Appellation	Lake County
Alcohol	13.0%
Aging	Fermented and Aged in Stainless Steel

Tasting Notes:

The 2017 Sauvignon Blanc is exuberant example of a noteworthy Sauvignon Blanc grown in a lesser publicized appellation. The nose is expressive with white peach and mandarin oranges, with exotic notes of wildly scented flowers - gardenia and freesia. In the mouth, the wine's core is clean citrus accompanied by ruby red grapefruit and orange, along with wet stone.

The wine is finely textured, with good weight and bright acidity, ready to take on raw oysters, or a spicy Thai red curry with tofu and fresh basil, served with fragrant jasmine rice.
