

Annabella 2013~Chardonnay

Technical Analysis:

Varietal Chardonnay (100%)

Appellation Napa Valley

Alcohol 14.1%

Aging 8 months in French oak

Tasting Notes:

This 2013 Annabella Napa Valley Chardonnay entices from the start with aromas of Asian pear, vanilla cream soda, and subtle jasmine blossom. The luscious mouth is round and weighty, bright with lemon curd and vanilla bean, and the crème brulee finish stretches on and on. With a pronounced, but not overwhelming amount of oak, the palate is free to enjoy a combination of flavors.

Enjoy this indulgent wine with petrale sole sautéed with butter and lemon, served with mashed sweet potatoes and grilled asparagus.
