

Matthew Joseph 2014~Chardonnay

Technical Analysis:

Varietal Chardonnay (100%)

Appellation Napa Valley

Alcohol 14.5%

Aging 10 months in French Oak

Tasting Notes:

The 2014 Matthew Joseph Chardonnay is inviting from the start. A pale straw color in the glass, the wine easily volunteers refined aromas of wet stone, crème brûlée, white peach, and a hint of nutmeg. In the mouth, weighty flavors of mandarin oranges, subtle gardenia, and peach skin are perfectly balanced by a food-friendly acidity.

This wine will shine paired with seared scallops served with a warm orzo salad with butter and lemon.
