

## Annabella 2012 Red Blend

## **Technical Analysis:**

Varietal

Appellation Alcohol Aging Cabernet Sauvignon (85%) Zinfandel (10%) Merlot (5%) California 13.5% 16 months in French Oak

## **Tasting Notes:**

The 2012 Annabella red blend is an excellent example of varietal harmony - the magic that happens in blending. The nose invites with dense aromas of spicy plum, blackberry, and black pepper. The mouth is full of juicy dark berries, dark chocolate, and black cherries, and the broad, smooth tannins linger on the smokey finish, long after the wine is gone.

Pair this wine with pan roasted bone-in pork chops done with thyme and currants, served with wild rice and roasted Brussels sprouts.
