Aging	14 months in oak

Tasting Notes:

The 2019 Dante Pinot Noir is bright and extroverted from the very start. Aromas of fresh juicy strawberries leap from the glass, along with spicy red plum and a hint of lightly toasted oak. In the mouth, the wine is rich with buoyant flavors of strawberry jam and toasted marshmallow, with touches of light roast coffee and vanilla bean.

Enjoy this easy drinking Pinot Noir with cheese platter of aged goat cheddar and prosciutto, served with a fresh baguette.
