

Matthew Joseph 2016 Chardonnay

Technical Analysis:

Varietal Chardonnay (100%)

Appellation Napa Valley

Alcohol 13.5%

Aging 10 months in French Oak

Tasting Notes:

The 2016 Matthew Joseph Chardonnay is a brilliant golden straw color, with ebullient aromas of lemon zest and orange blossom leaping out of the glass. The nose also offers light notes of cinnamon and crème brûlée, with flavors of red pear, vanilla beam, and mandarin oranges in the mouth. The palate is creamy and round, with a fresh acidity accompanying balanced oak.

Enjoy this Chardonnay with a whole roasted chicken served with creamy polenta with goat cheese, and a green salad with an orange vinaigrette.
