Tasting Notes:

The 2018 inaugural vintage of Napa 1847 is expressive in the glass, with aromas of blackberries, cassis, and a hint of graphite. In the mouth, the wine is packed with flavors - offering generous black cherry, espresso, blackberries, and a hint of saddle leather layered amongst substantial broad tannins. The finish is perfumed with toasted oak char and a lingering vanilla.

Enjoy this pedigreed Napa Valley Cab with BBQ flank steak served with buttered green beans and grilled polenta.
