



## **Annabella 2013~Merlot**

### **Technical Analysis:**

Varietal	Merlot (94%) Cabernet Franc (2%) Petit Verdot (2%) Malbec (2%)
Appellation	Napa Valley
Alcohol	14.5%
Aging	22 months in French oak

### **Tasting Notes:**

The 2013 Annabella Napa Valley Merlot is a deep and brooding Merlot, with aromas of pure dark fruit (black plum, spicy black fig) mingling with a forest floor-like earthiness. In the mouth, the wine is densely aromatic with well-integrated oak, with flavors of nutmeg and subtle clove woven with dark chocolate and black cherries. The lightly oaked finish is finessed and lingering.

Enjoy this wine with an herb-crusted rack of lamb served with roasted potatoes and garlic sautéed spinach.
