

Dante 2015 ~ Pinot Noir

Technical Analysis:

Varietal Appellation Alcohol Aging Pinot Noir (100%) California 13.5% 8 months in Oak

Tasting Notes:

The 2015 Dante Pinot Noir is a lovely clear burgundy in the glass, with lightly purple undertones. Aromatically beguiling from the start, the wine greets with aromas of fresh raspberries, rose petals, and a hint of orange peel. The mouth is weighty and soft, with flavors of vanilla crème soda, lightly roasted coffee, and juicy ripe strawberries, framed with a light touch of sweetly spicy French oak. A hint of vanilla bean persists throughout the finish.
