

Dante 2017 Cabernet Sauvignon

Technical Analysis:

Varietal Cabernet Sauvignon (92 %)

Petit Sirah (4%) Petit Verdot (2%) Tannat (2%)

Appellation California Alcohol 13.5%

Aging 16 months in French oak

Tasting Notes:

The 2017 Dante Cabernet Sauvignon is bright with enticing aromas of cranberry, red plum, bright red cherries, and milk chocolate. The mouth is rich and dense, with layers of freshly roasted coffee, chocolate covered cherries, a solid oak structure lending clove, nutmeg, and cinnamon, and a bright, juicy acid just ready for food. The finish is lengthy and perfumed with Tahitian vanilla bean.

Enjoy this bold, food-friendly wine with thick and juicy grilled burgers with caramelized onions and a toasted Brioche bun.
