

Dante 2017 ~ Pinot Noir

Technical Analysis:

Varietal Pinot Noir (100%)

Appellation California Alcohol 14.1%

Aging 14 months in oak

Tasting Notes:

The 2017 Dante Pinot Noir is a light ruby red in the glass, with youthful purple edges. In the nose, the wine volunteers a lovely blend of rose petals, rich earth, and clove-scented charred oak. The wine shows a round and layered palate, with candied cherry and lightly roasted coffee, Tahitian vanilla bean and a delicate oak framework.

Enjoy this feminine Pinot Noir with salt crusted roast chicken served with sautéed wild mushrooms.
