Technical Analysis:

Varietal	Cabernet Sauvignon (95%) Petite Sirah (2%) Petit Verdot (2%) Teroldego (1%)
Appellation	California
Alcohol	13.5%
Aging	18 months in French oak

Tasting Notes:

The 2021 Dante Cabernet Sauvignon is dark and expressive on the nose, with aromas of graphite, dark cherry, and black currant leaping from the glass. In the mouth the wine is rich with layered flavors of black cherry, black plum, and espresso, with a broad palate that supports the wine's ample build. The robust finish lingers with clove and nutmeg.

Pair this wine with smoked brisket served with buttery mashed potatoes grilled asparagus.
