### **Technical Analysis:**

Varietal	Merlot (100%)
Appellation	California
Alcohol	13.5%
Aging	20 months in Oak

### **Tasting Notes:**

The 2014 Dante Merlot is a deep burgundy color in the glass. Dark, spicy aromas of black plum, ripe blackberries and mission fig greet the nose, supported by subtle nutmeg and clove notes. In the mouth, this Merlot is juicy with Bing cherries and boysenberries, mingling with warm flavors of lightly toasted oak and milk chocolate. The wine is soft and broad, easy-drinking and sure to please a crowd.

Enjoy the 2014 Dante Merlot with saucy barbecued ribs and buttered corn on the cob.
