### Technical Analysis:

Varietal	Cabernet Sauvignon (86%) Merlot (8%) Tannat (5%) Petit Verdot (1%)
Appellation	California (25% Napa, 75% Lodi)
Alcohol	13.5%
Aging	18 months in French oak



### Tasting Notes:

The 2016 Giapoza Cabernet Sauvignon is an extroverted and engaging wine from the very start. The nose is expressive with aromas of ripe raspberries, black plum, black cherries, and a dusting of cocoa powder. In the mouth, the wine is broad and dense, with upfront flavors of blackberries, blueberries, and dark chocolate entwined with anise, clove, and a core of richly toasted oak. The finish is expressive and long, with lingering flavors of butterscotch and vanilla.

Enjoy this striking wine with a roast of top sirloin, served with scalloped potatoes and pan roasted Brussels sprouts.
