Technical Analysis:

Varietal	86 % Cabernet Sauvignon, 10% Merlot, 2% Petit Verdot, 2% Malbec
Appellation	Napa Valley
Alcohol	14.5%
Aging	18 months in French Oak Barrels

Tasting Notes:

The exotic nose of the incredible wine opens with aromas of black cherry, mission fig, and plum preserves. Lush and dense, in the mouth the wine's massive structure is layered with juicy plum, mocha, and smokey oak, and the creamy tannins linger long and soft. This is the ideal wine to serve with this holiday season's standing rib roast, black pepper roasted new potatoes, and green beans sautéed with persimmons and chives.

This wine is meant to last. While you can certainly open this now and enjoy, many choose to wait and have been pleased with the outcome. The challenge is resisting the urge to drink it!
