Tasting Notes:

The 2016 Marianna jumps out of the glass with inviting aromas of black currants, blueberries, dark chocolate mocha, and vanilla. In the mouth, the wine is densely layered with juicy flavors of ripe cherries, cassis, dark chocolate and espresso. The tannins are heavy, creamy, and broad, with the lengthy finish carrying aromas of vanilla and cardamom.

Enjoy this show stopper with your best grilled tomahawk steak served with buttered corn on the cob.
