

## Michael Pozzan 2013~Pinot Noir

## **Technical Analysis:**

Varietal Pinot Noir (100%) Appellation Russian River Valley

Alcohol 13.5%

Aging 16 months in French Oak

## **Tasting Notes:**

The Michael Pozzan 2013 Russian River Valley is a gorgeous shade of ruby, with slight purple undertones. This delicate Pinot Noir entices with aromas of vanilla, rose petal, and orange peel. The mouth is evocative and aromatic, with gently layered flavors of red cherry, roasted coffee, light caramel and the subtle spiciness of fig leaf. The tannins are silky and weighty, and give the wine an impossibly long, lovely vanilla finish.

This wine pairs well with paparadelle pasta tossed with a wild mushroom ragout.
