

Michael Pozzan 2014~Cabernet Sauvignon

Technical Analysis:

Varietal Cabernet Sauvignon (100%)

Appellation Alexander Valley, Sonoma County

Alcohol 13.5%

Aging 12 months in French oak

Tasting Notes:

The 2014 Michael Pozzan Alexander Valley Cabernet Sauvignon is a classic example of Cabernet grown in this esteemed Sonoma County appellation. The nose is expressive with wild blackberry, subtly charred oak and dark chocolate covered cherries. The broad mouth shows finely textured tannins, with flavors of espresso and the darkest of dark chocolate mingling with spicy black fig and boysenberries. The wine is dark and complex, well framed by integrated French oak. The dense wine would benefit from some time breathe before drinking - or better yet, splash it into a decanter and enjoy it in full bloom.

Drink this charismatic wine with spicy cubed beef chili served with cornbread.
